

Second Grade Classroom Rules

1. We will always show respect towards our classmates and our teachers.
2. We will raise our hands to speak and listen when a teacher or a classmate is talking.
3. We will stay in our seats and keep our hands and objects to ourselves.
4. We will walk in the classroom and the hallways and always use our inside voices.
5. We will always tell the truth and use good manners when spoken to.

Behavioral Expectations/Discipline Procedures

I expect children in second grade to display appropriate behavior while in school. This includes being kind to others, listening while the teacher or a classmate is talking, using good manners, exhibiting good sportsmanship, and showing respect towards all faculty and staff. If your child is disobeying one of the above listed classroom rules, I will give him or her two warnings to stop the inappropriate behavior. After two warnings, the following events will occur:

- 1.) Name on the board
- 2.) Checkmark next to name= 5 minutes of recess time
- 3.) Two checkmarks next to name= 10 minutes of recess time
- 4.) Three checkmarks next to name=Loss of recess/personal conference with Miss Fleck.

If a behavioral problem is reoccurring and not getting better by way of a personal conference with me, an additional conference will be called. This conference will include you (the parent or primary caregiver), myself, and Mrs. Potts (elementary school principal).
