

Aquin Jr-Sr High Dress Code 2011-12

REGULAR DRESS CODE DAYS:

SLACKS: Khaki dress slacks.

NOT ALLOWED ON PANTS/SHORTS/CAPRIS:

Jeans or jean style pants of any fabric, zippers, rivets, leg loops, corduroy, leg pockets, leggings, logos, pants with yokes on the back, cargo pants, spandex, double stitching, or hip-hugger style.

SHORTS: (August until October 15, April, and May) Khaki dress (walking; knee-length) shorts or Capri pants may be worn (pants restrictions apply to shorts and Capris).

TOPS: Solid navy blue long or short-sleeved polo shirts with a collar (no capped sleeves, lettering, designs, turtlenecks, snaps, or zippers); a maximum of 2 or 3 buttons at the neck. Polo shirts must be a minimum of 3 to 4 inches below the natural waist line and remain tucked in all day.

1. White T-shirt undershirts only (no colored T-shirts); may not have lettering or designs.
2. Shirts must be buttoned and be TUCKED IN AT ALL TIMES; no stomach may be shown.
3. Solid navy blue pullover or cardigan sweaters may be worn over a regulation polo shirt (no hoods).
4. Navy blue Aquin sweatshirts/approved fleece shirts may be worn over a regulation polo shirt (no hoods).
5. Sweaters and sweatshirts may not be worn wrapped around the waist.
6. No camisoles or tank tops are to be shown at any time.

BELTS: Plain black or brown belts with standard size buckle must be worn at all times. **SOCKS** or nylons must be worn at all times; must be visible (covering ankle).

SHOES: Dress shoes, oxford loafers, dark hard-soled, solid-colored shoes are allowed.
The following may NOT be worn: flip-flops, clogs, slippers, high heels and sandals.

DRESS UP DAYS:

SLACKS: Dress slacks (**boys: dark or khaki; girls: black**), regular dress code rules apply (belts, shoes, etc.)

TOPS:

BOYS: Dress shirts (any color) with a collar and a tie snug at the neck (a bow tie or string tie is not allowed).

Shirts must be buttoned at the neck; long-sleeved shirts must remain buttoned at the wrist (sleeves may not be rolled up). Sport coat or sweater is optional over dress shirt and tie.

GIRLS: October 15-April 15: "Official" school sweater is worn over a dress blouse/polo with collar.

August-October 15 and April 15 to end of school: Any color polo shirt (all other rules for regular tops apply).

JEAN DAYS: Aquin sweatshirt or Aquin T-shirt and jeans. Jeans (no wind pants or sweatpants) cannot be ragged, torn, ripped, or have holes. During "shorts" months, khaki cargo or plaid walking shorts may be worn in place of jeans. Regular shoes or tennis shoes (no sandals, flip flops, clogs, or heels may be worn--safety issue).

DRESS CODE PLUS: Regular dress code style with no restrictions on color or pattern; all other regular dress code rules apply.

TEAM DRESS DAY: The captain of each team must schedule these days in advance with the dean and the dean must approve the team dress; not allowed on a dress up day. Failure to comply may result in loss of privilege.

EARRINGS: Only small stud earrings (males: 1; females: 2 per ear;).

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES: Clothing must be modest; no tank tops, "beaters", short shorts, or halter-tops.

DANCE DRESS CODE: For girls: Dresses/tops must cover body from chest to knee.

HAIR Gentlemen must be clean-shaven and hair length must be above shirt collar and should not cover any part of the ear.

NOT ALLOWED: Side burns, inappropriate hairstyles (color, stripes, or designs), body piercing (see earring rules for exceptions); tattoos; jewelry that is distracting.

The administration reserves the right to interpret and/or make adjustments to the Dress Code as deemed necessary.
